GUIDELINES FOR CAMP CONDUCT

1. All campers will follow camp schedules as established by the Camp Director. Attendance in all activities is required unless excused by a staff member.
2. Everyone must stay on H.O.T Bible Camp property and no one will be permitted to leave without the approval of the camp director.
3. All illness or injury must be reported promptly to the camp nurse, counselor, staff, or camp director. All medicines **MUST** be turned over to the camp nurse when you register.
4. Everyone is expected to behave in an appropriate manner at all times.
5. **DO NOT THROW ROCKS.**
6. Inappropriate language, jokes, gestures, or behavior will not be tolerated.
7. Campers or others **MUST NOT** deface or destroy property of the camp.
8. Do not climb on trees or pull off tree limbs.
9. Over affection or intimate contact between campers will not be permitted.
10. Roughhousing and horseplay are out of place at camp and will not be permitted.
11. No campers will serve the meals or be permitted in the kitchen.
12. Boys and girls cabins and bathhouses are completely off limits to the opposite sex. (Campers will be assigned cabins based on birth gender)
12. Stay out of sleeping areas not your own unless given permission.
14. Do not go into the cabins during the day unless your counselor gives you permission.
15. The craft area and items are off limits when "Arts and Crafts" are not taking place.
16. If it is not yours don't touch it.
17. Any items "found" will be turned in to your counselor.

Violation of these rules can result in disciplinary action. The camp director will send anyone home who refuses to comply with these basic rules. No phone is available at camp. The director or nurse will handle all emergency calls. In case of an emergency call: 325-597-1365 or 325-456-4513

Things to bring:

- Clothes for 5 days:** T-shirts, long shorts, underwear, socks, pants, a hat, two pairs of comfortable shoes, light jacket, etc. (NOTE: All shirts, shorts, pants and skirts should cover you well, with no revealing portions nor inappropriate/offensive images or writing.)
- Sleep wear and bath robe.**
- Bedding:** Twin size sheets, pillow, blanket, or sleeping bag.
- Personal items:** Towels, washcloths, soap, toothbrush, shampoo, and other personal items you may need.
- Flashlight and Laundry bag:** There are no facilities for washing clothes.
- Bible, notebook, and pen or pencil.**
- Water bottle:** Put your name on it.
- Enthusiasm, energy, optimism, and an overall good attitude.**

ALL ITEMS SHOULD BE MARKED FOR EASY IDENTIFICATION.

Do NOT bring:

- Knives of any kind, no guns, or camping tools. No weapons of any kind.
- No electrical devices of any kind except a shaver, hair dryer, curling iron, etc.
- No tablets, smart watches, **cell phones**, or any other type of hand held devices or games.
- No drugs, alcohol, or tobacco products of any kind.
- Do not bring money, jewelry, or live pets.
- No food. No treats, cokes, candy, or snacks of any kind. All food will be provided. (Exceptions for special diets only.)

All prohibited items will be taken up by your counselor and returned at the end of camp.
